The 1° AIOT/ETOP residential course will take place on Friday May 13 and Saturday May 14 2011. Lessons will start on 03.00 p.m. of the first day and will go on until 01.00 p.m. of the day after.

The participants will be allotted in the School venue where will be looked after during carrying out of the course.

SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION

The SIOT is characterized for the high level of interactivity between followers/faculty. Infact a large time for clinical cases presentation, for guided discussions and for proves and tests, where the followers will be involved, is allotted. School aim is to make the lessons less frontal as possible playing the followers an active part in the lessons. They will be divided in small groups seated on the table with iPad to interactive with the faculty in real time. For Italian people the course will be accredited in CME programme of Ministry of Health, for Medical Doctor with 6 branches of reference.

TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

The course is enriched of innovative and video-tecnologies of last generation, which will contribute to make some moments more interesting and involving, recalling a great attention from attendants. In attempting to find an emotional key also in learning, we have innovated the methodology of teaching with introduction of some new hi-tech items. As instrument of interaction with Experts Panel we will use Apple iPad, which will be handed over to each table and on which every table will be able to work singly. With iPad is possible to answer tests of pre-evaluation, to insert a diagnosis related to the case report shown, to look at some pre-charged imagines, to choice replies and personal solutions, which will be managed by a server and will be analyzed by Expert Panel for a sharing with the audience throught a video-projection. Performing the case reports presentation in an advanced way, we will give a monitor 40/46" touch-screen to the Speakers, on which they will be able to set out their clinical case with journalistic exposition displaying texts, imagines and graphics and manipulating them interactivly. All the contents on the touch-screen will be shown immediately on the main wall.

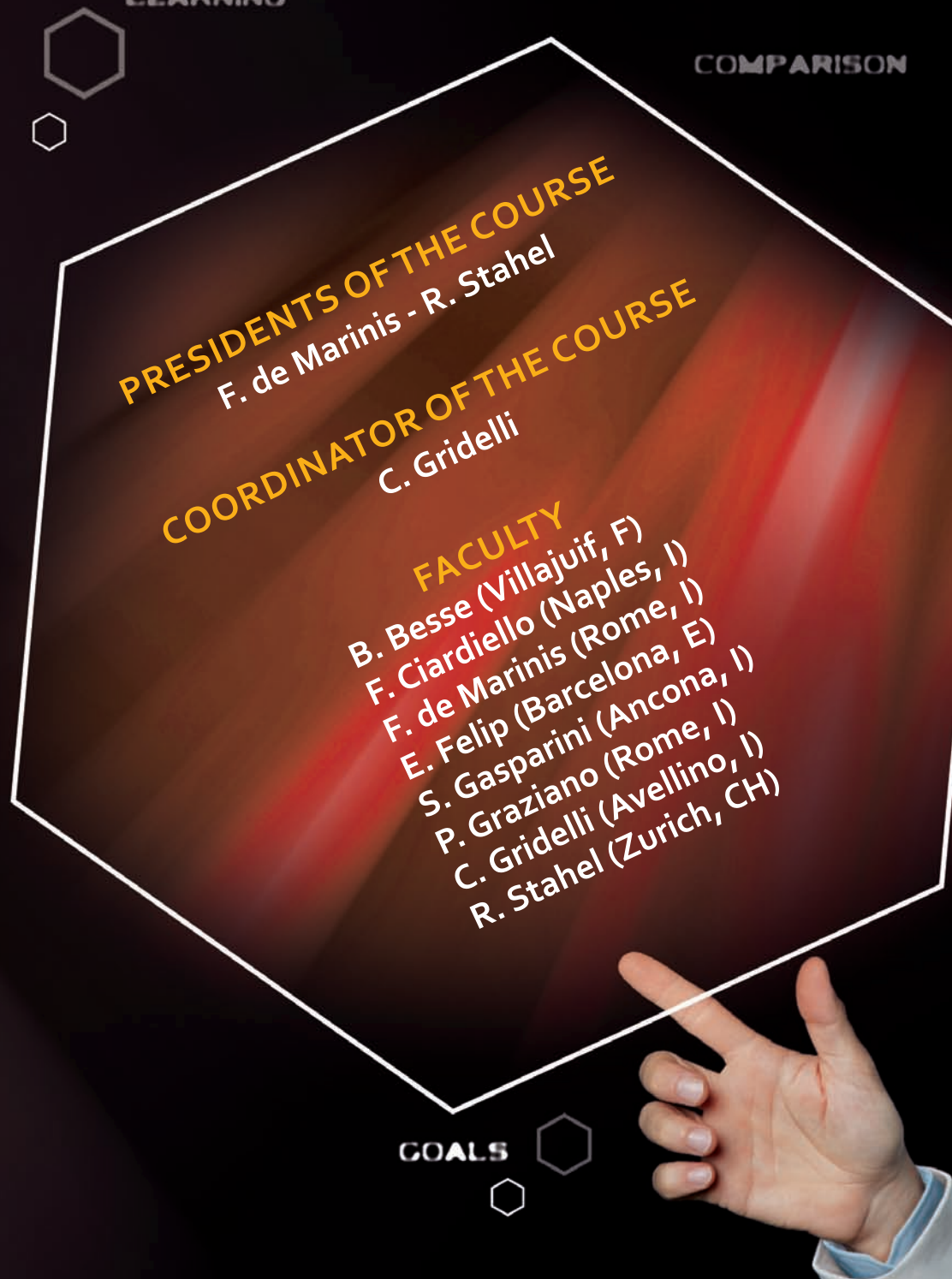
